Article Guidelines

- Members and Supporters are eligible to submit to the South Carolina InfraGard Journal.
- Plagiarism will not be tolerated and may result in a revocation of your membership or affiliation with the InfraGard.
- Articles must be educational, about the protection of our Nation's critical infrastructure and non-commercial.
- Original work only. The article cannot be published elsewhere.
- South Carolina InfraGard reserves the right to reject any submission that is not in alignment with our mission, vision or values.
- South Carolina InfraGard will promote all published articles via social media, newsletters and on our website.
- All articles must be submitted in MS word.
- Articles must be between 600-1,400 words in length.
- We only accept text, no images, graphs or charts unless you own copyright of the photo. All photos must include the name of the photographer so he/she receives credit.
- All sources must be properly cited.
- Citations must be in the format of a hyperlink within the text. No footnotes or endnotes.
- Include the author's full name at the top of the document along with title and organization. Ex:
By Jonathon Simpson, Sergeant, Anytown Police Department
- Include a short, 3-5 sentence author bio at the end of the document.
 - You are welcome to include your email if you wish to be contacted by readers.
 - Please include your name, title, agency as you would like it to appear on the byline.
